Austin, Texas, November 13, 2019 – Last week, South by Southwest (SXSW) announced that more than 600 sessions have been selected for the 2020 conference, including two Hangar panels and a “meet up”. The announcement comes after SXSW’s annual user-generated submission process, PanelPicker, where more than 4,440 entries were narrowed down through public votes and input from SXSW staff and SXSW Advisory members.
