



Runner's World features Hanger Clinic orthotic patient and marathon runner Cheryl Hile

Pacific Grove, Calif., July 23, 2019 – This month, Runner's World profiled Cheryl Hile and how running has helped keep her physically, mentally, and emotionally fit while living with multiple sclerosis (MS). To combat a symptom of MS called foot drop, Hile wears a carbon fiber ankle-foot orthosis (AFO), custom-designed and fit by her Encinitas, California-based Hanger Clinic orthotist Ara Mirzaian.

Since her MS diagnosis in 2006, Hile has remained determined to keep running, and in 2017 became the first person with MS to [run seven marathons on seven continents in one year](#). In November, she will help raise awareness and funds for MS research when she completes the Richmond Marathon with a group of online and virtual runners (Team Run a Myelin My Shoes), many of whom also have MS.
